## Quick Stat: Emergency response calls From Domestic Violence to Dementia

# Police officers are first on scene in 90% of emergency calls

- 70% of older adults with dementia live at home
- Opportunity for collaboration
- Reduce # of future emergency calls



## What is the collaborative policing model?

- By definition: A model that combines collaboration with problem-solving and evidence-based policing — builds community trust, support and cooperation while achieving more effective and long-lasting crime reduction benefits.
- In Practice: An approach to policing that bridges the gap between 'cops and community'






